

What is Salon?

Once a year we hold a competition where you can re-submit images that were entered into the monthly competitions during the prior year. These images are critiqued by a panel of three judges and displayed at our Salon dinner where results are announced.

The rules are:

- 1) A maximum of 5 images can be entered into Salon.
- 2) Any Image that was entered into a regular club night competition in the previous year (April through March) is eligible, regardless of how well they scored on the night.
- 3) Images must be presented as they were – e.g., no further editing, name change, matt colour.
- 4) Images must be entered in the same category (Print or Digital) as originally presented.
- 5) All images are judged as Open. Judges will not know what the set subjects were.
- 6) The deadline for entries is May club night.
A digital file for every entry must be emailed to digitalconv@images.org.nz.
(Note - the digital file for Prints is for use in an Audio-Visual presentation shown at salon dinner & will not be seen by the judges).

Label the files clearly as “Salon Print” or “Salon Digital” plus the image title and your club number. Please omit your name & any other details.

Prints for the Print sections must be handed in by May club night.

- 7) First, second & third awards will be given in the four categories - Intermediate Print, Intermediate Digital, Advanced Print and Advanced Digital.

Tips: Select what you consider are your five best images of the year, keeping in mind:

- an image that did poorly on the night may do well in Salon with different judges.
- an image that did well as a set subject may not score as well as an open image.
- Critique your own work as a judge might, and choose the strongest images
