Wabi-sabi is a beauty of things imperfect, impermanent, and incomplete. It is a beauty of things modest and humble. It is a beauty of things unconventional.



March: Image Inversion


Image inversion is the process of reversing the pixel values of an image, or mapping light areas to dark and dark areas to light. This can be done for black and white images, or for color images.

Macro photography is a technique that involves taking extreme close-up photos of small subjects to make them appear larger than they are in real life.



