General rules

- ☐ All images must be photographed **only** during the time frame of Sunday to Sunday of the appointed week.
- ☐ Only 1 image per photographer.
- ☐ Only 1 image per theme.
- ☐ All images captured in camera **with only minor post processing such as cropping and levels.**
- ☐ All images to be submitted as jpegs with a **maximum** size of 1620 pixels wide and 1080 pixels high.
- ☐ Image Naming must be as follows:
[Theme Number]_[Club Initials]_[Photographer (First Name Surname)]_[Title].jpg
- ☐ Submissions must be made to HCC shootout convener Sheryl Williams **sherylwilliams@xtra.co.nz** by midnight on **Sunday 2nd September.**
- ☐ Judging will be by 3 judges from the PSNZ list, none of who will be from the organising club.
- ☐ The judges will rank the images in each category from lowest to highest which

Welcome To The 2018 Nelson National Triptych Salon

Triptych – “threefold” derived from the Greek “tri” meaning three and “ptyso” meaning “to fold”. In its earliest religious form, a triptych consisted of three painted panels hinged together so that the two outer panels could be folded in over the (usually larger) central panel. Today “triptych” can be taken to mean any set of three art works designed to be displayed together.

Nelson Camera Club’s National Triptych Salon has been initiated to encourage and stimulate photographers in the skill of creating three images that not only work well together but also succeed in providing a total impression on the viewer that is greater than the sum of the three individual photographs. The images must be made up of three (and only three) distinctly separated photographs presented on a common background. The subject matter is open.
