Our own Salon is coming up on 27th July, mark it in your diaries, it's a great evening of celebration and companionship.

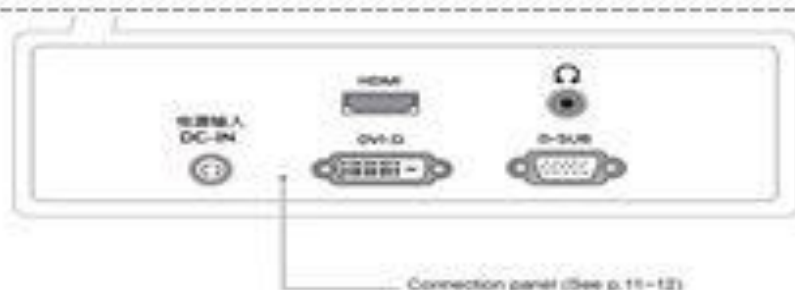
Now housekeeping, there are just a few members yet to pay your subs. Just a gentle nudge, you may get a reminder email from Lynn.

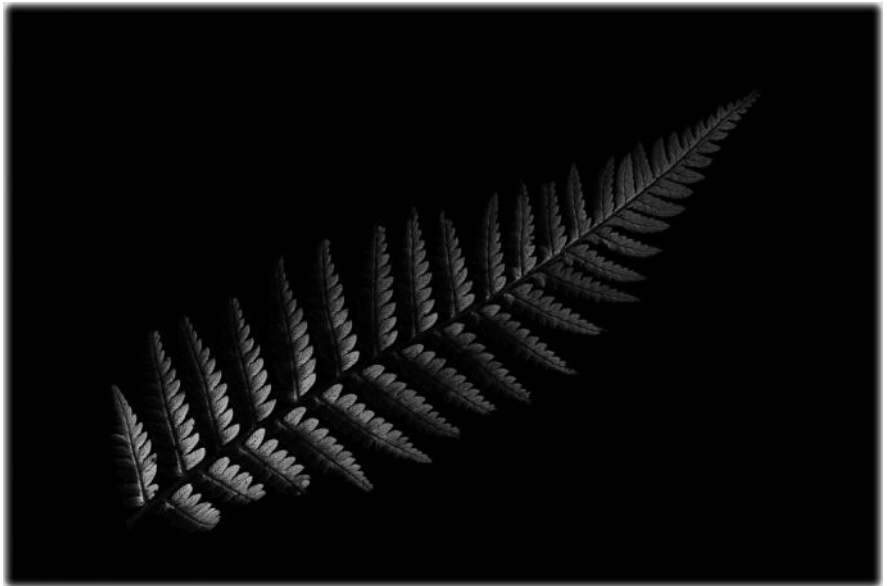

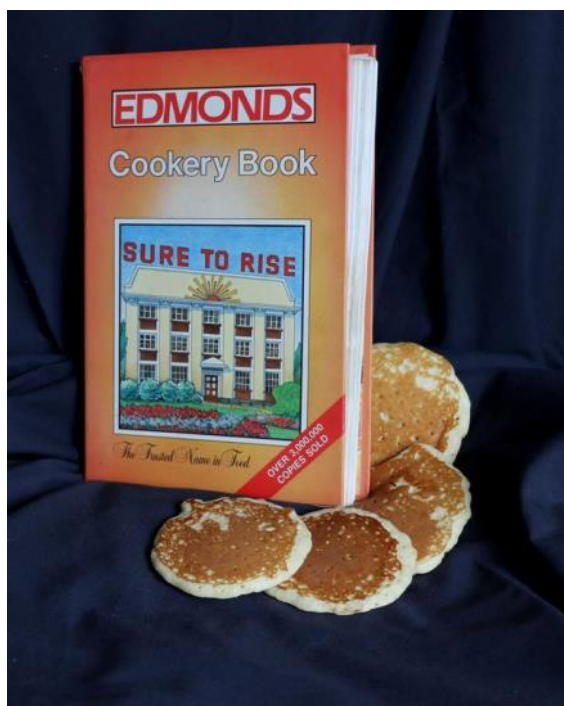
