I have left in this newsletter fliers for two competitions. I have no idea whether they will go ahead or not, but I am being optimistic at the moment.

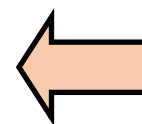
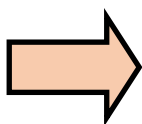
Please be safe everyone and abide by the lock-down conditions . Take the time to appreciate the small things in life and be positive.

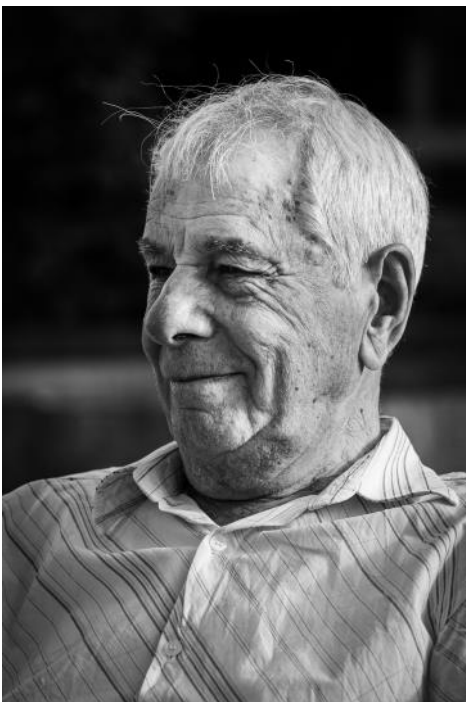
